These changes were made to create credit consistency, give extra credit to energy efficiency, and include new regional credit.

Credits are awarded for achieving 10% and 20% levels for the amount of pre and postconsumer recycled materials and materials extracted, harvested, or recovered, and manufactured within 500 miles of the building in which it is to be used.

VT agrifiber core doors assist with the above credits, along with MR 6 Rapidly Renewable and EQ 4.4 Composite Wood and Agrifiber Product credits, totaling 6 supported LEED v3 credits. FSC<sup>®</sup> certified particleboard doors are available for assistance with 4 credits. Stave, structural composite lumber (SCL) and mineral core options are also available for help with achieving LEED building certification.
